A note for church members

Members will remember the discomfort relating to the failure of our church heating system during the first few months of this year. While the system leaks have been repaired, there is still remedial work needed to dry out the underfloor areas of the large and Small Halls and part of the link corridor.

This will happen during the whole of August and beginning of September. The affected areas will not be open for public use, as there will be lots of machines and wires in them. The lino in the Small Hall and corridor will also be removed. **This will affect access into the church.**

Once the work starts, which may be this week or next, **the only way into church will be through the front gate and garden and via the front door. For those who find steps difficult, there is a better way-in through the front garden and bear right, in through the door into the link corridor near the toilets.** It is likely that we will not be able to serve refreshments as usual after the service, though everyone is welcome to stay in the garden to chat, alongside the Vineyard church, who will also have to cope with these changes.

I am sorry about this disruption but the August break for many church activities make this least difficult time for all our users. If there are any delays to the planned work, we will inform you by the email system.
